

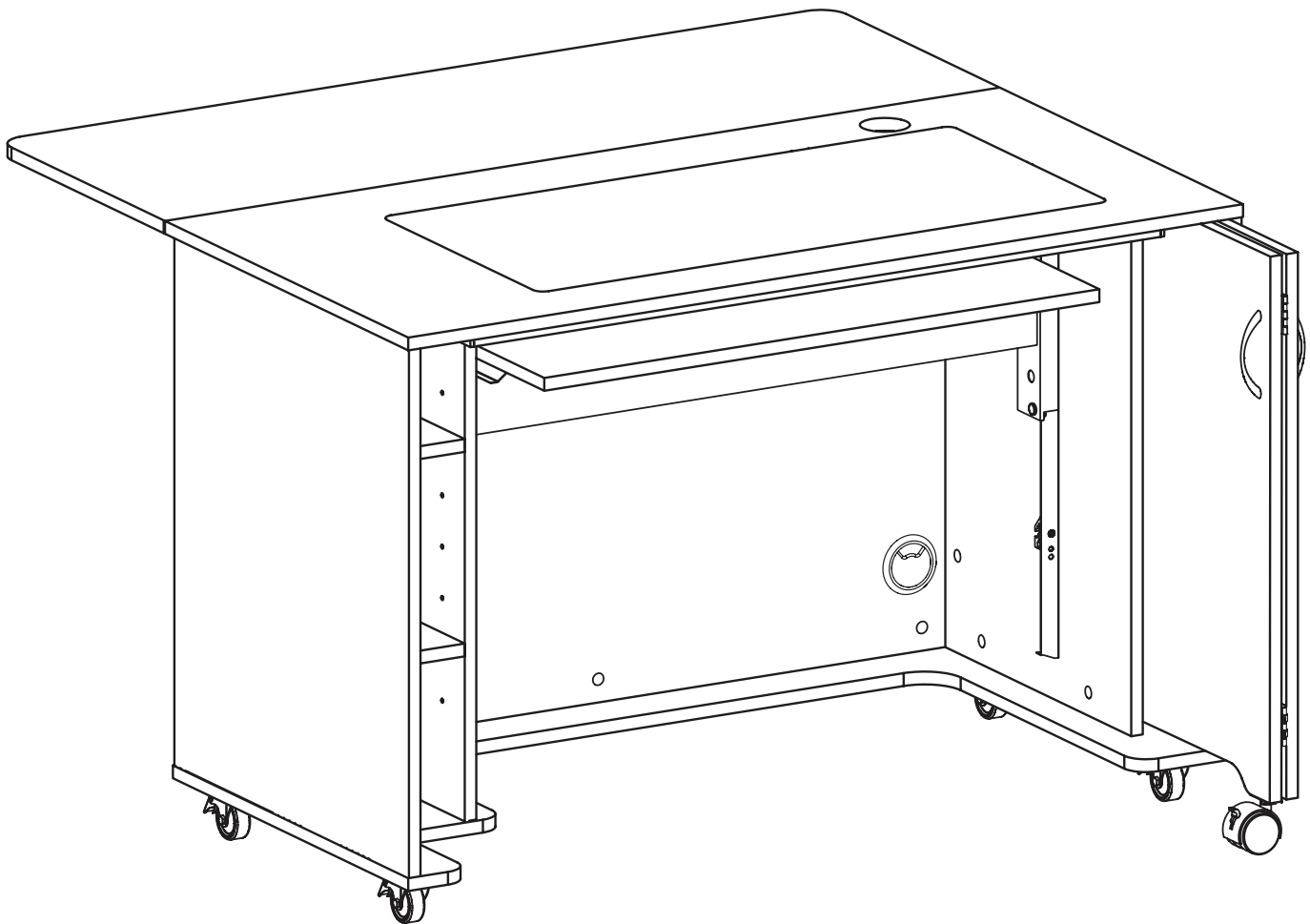

General Assembly Guidelines

1. Read the instructions carefully before beginning the assembly process to ensure proper assembly of this product. Please open and inspect the contents of box(es) to see that all parts and hardware are included.

2. Tools Required

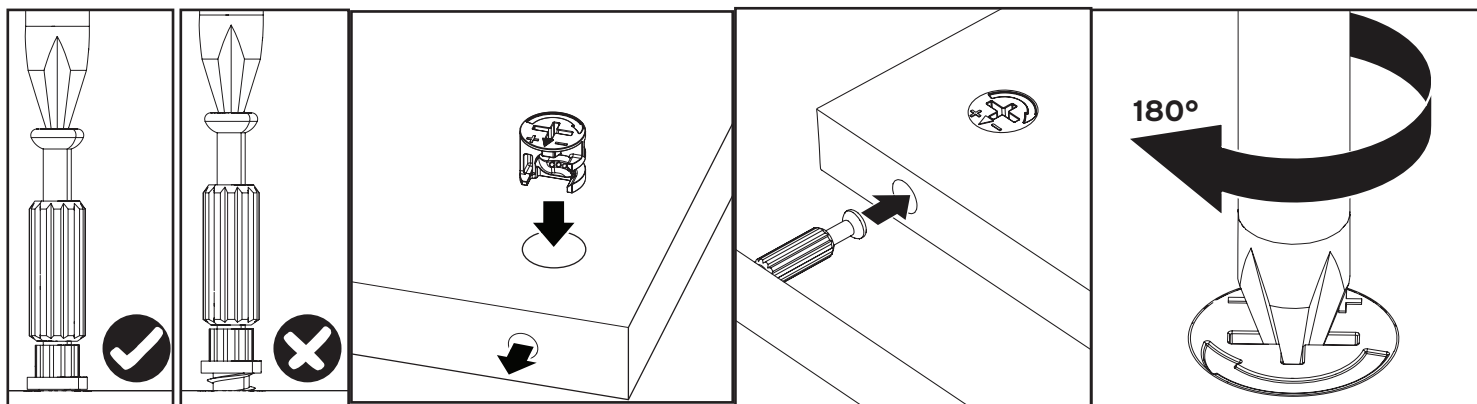

3. Understanding How the Cam Fastener Works



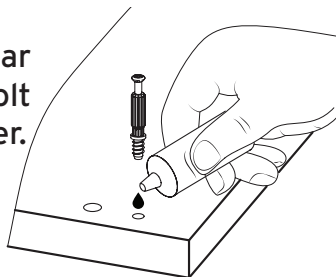
Screw cam bolts flush as illustrated.

Press cam into hole until flush with surface. The arrow direction must be in the direction of the hole.

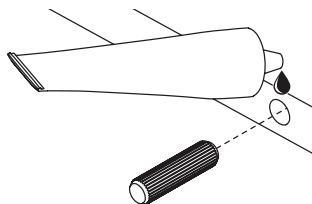
Insert bolt through pre-drilled hole in edge of panel.

Turn clockwise to lock cam with bolt.

Tip: place a small bit of WD-40 or similar lubricant into the pre-installed cam bolt holes to help the cam bolts screw in better.



4. **Glue** provided is to secure wood dowels in place and is optional. If glue is used during assembly, locate the appropriate hole for the dowel, place a small amount of glue in the hole and insert the dowel. Wipe away excess glue immediately. It is not necessary to glue the other end of the dowel when attaching to other parts.

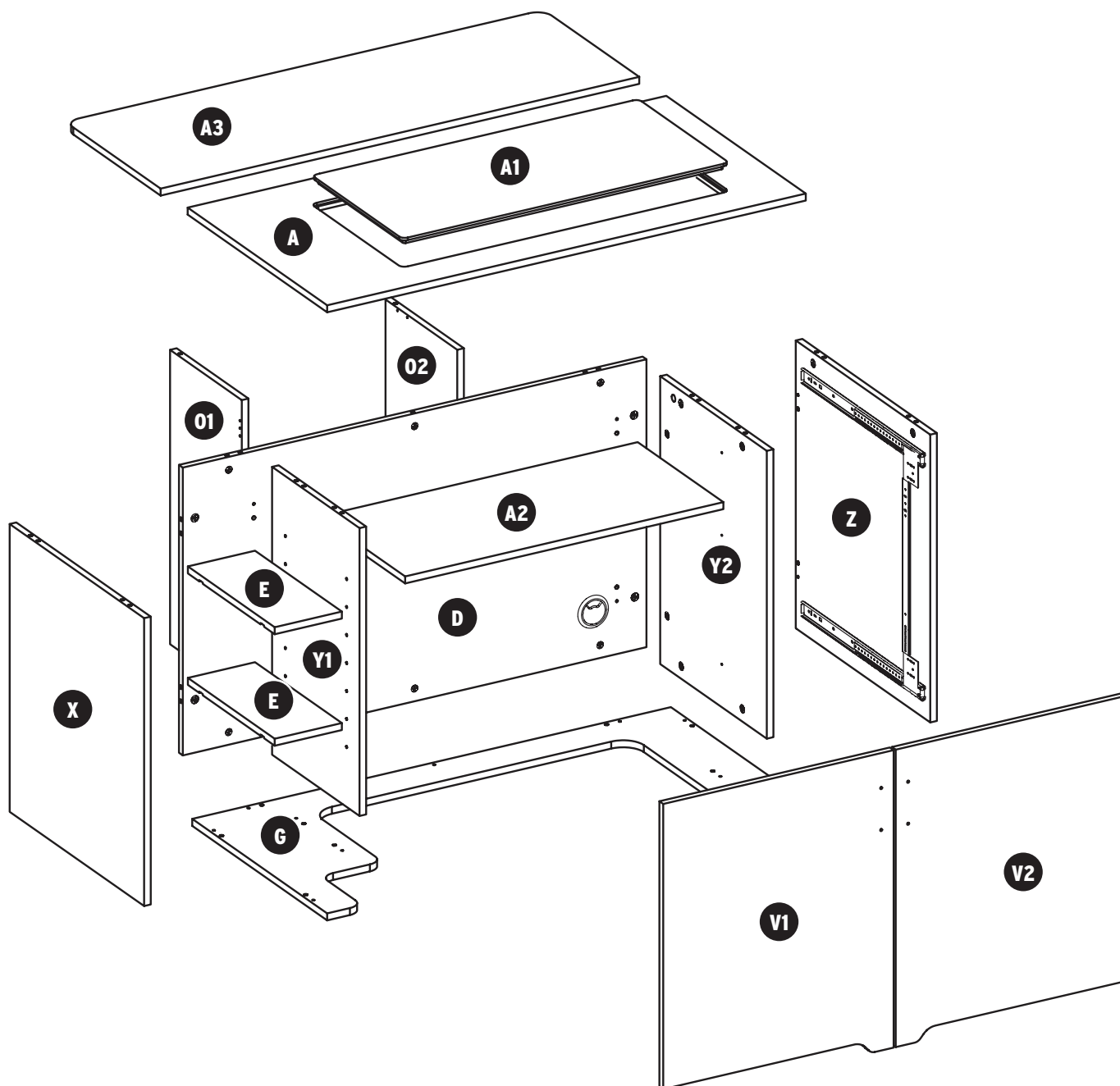


Use and Care Your cabinet normally requires a minimum amount of maintenance; however, the following points are worth noting:

Cleaning - To remove marks and enhance the surface, wipe with a gentle all-purpose cleanser. **DO NOT** use ammonia-based, harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaning agents. Wipe dry immediately.

Electrical and Hydraulic Lifts - Require annual lubrication with WD-40 or similar lubricant.

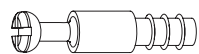

t2 Locking Plate Caster **x4**

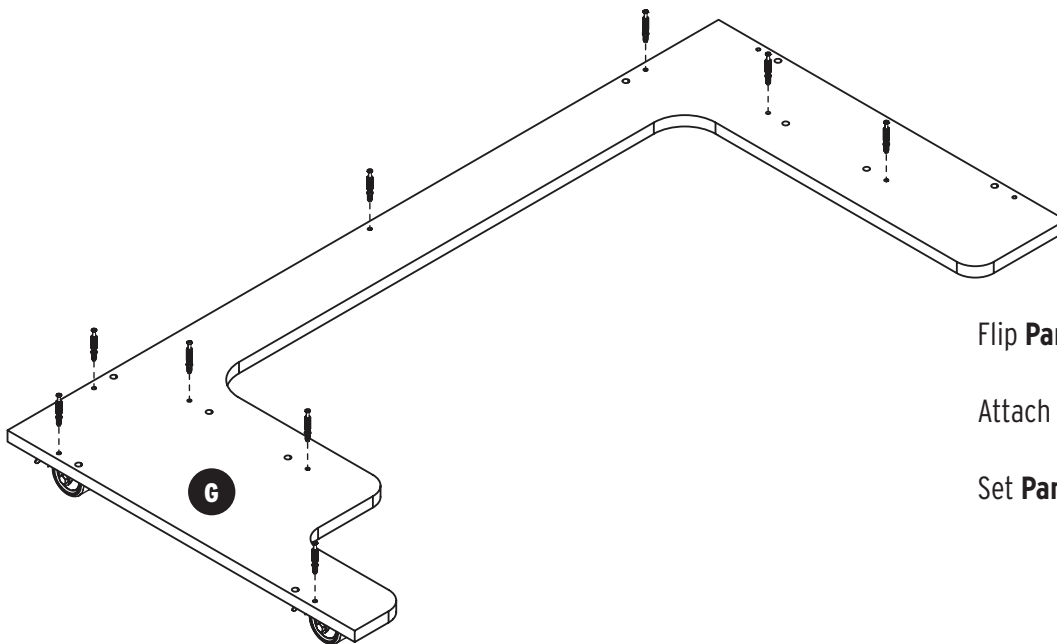
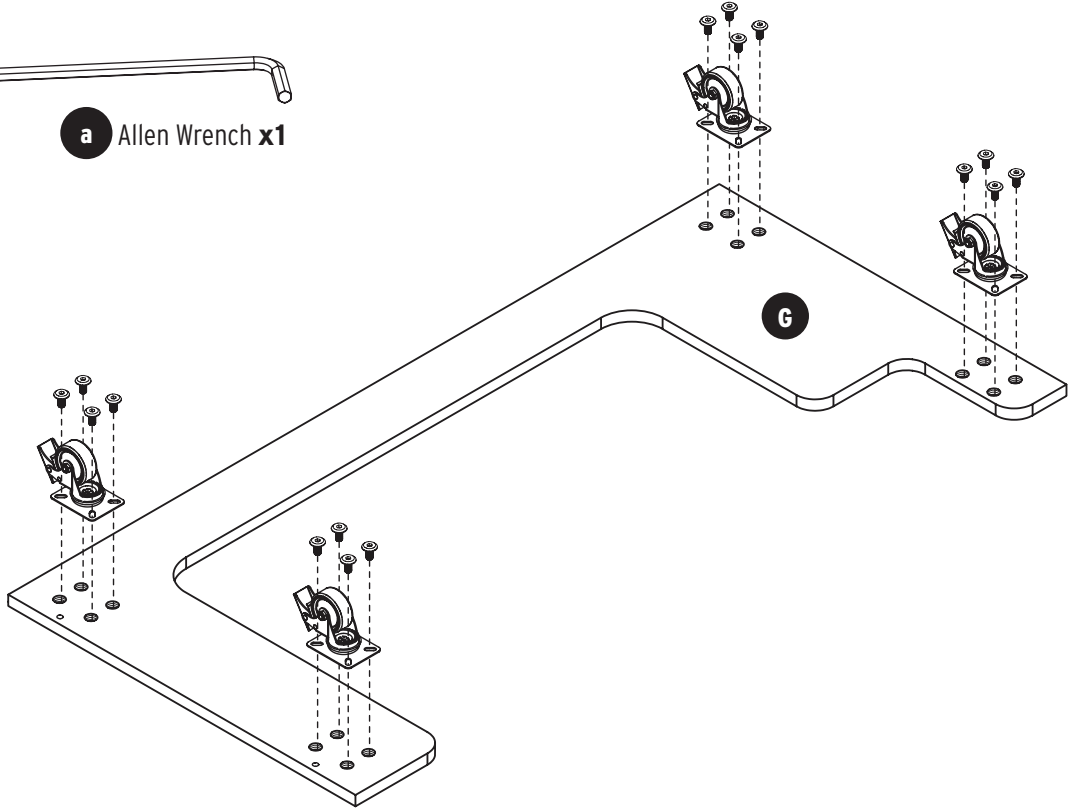


a Allen Wrench **x1**



b1 8x16 Fix Bolt **x16**

Attach **t2 Locking Plate Casters** to the underside of **Panel G**, using **b1 Fix Bolts**. Tighten with **Allen Wrench**.



c1 6x35 Cam Bolt **x9**

Flip **Panel G** over.

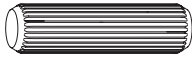
Attach **c1 Cam Bolts** to **Panel G**.

Set **Panel G** aside.

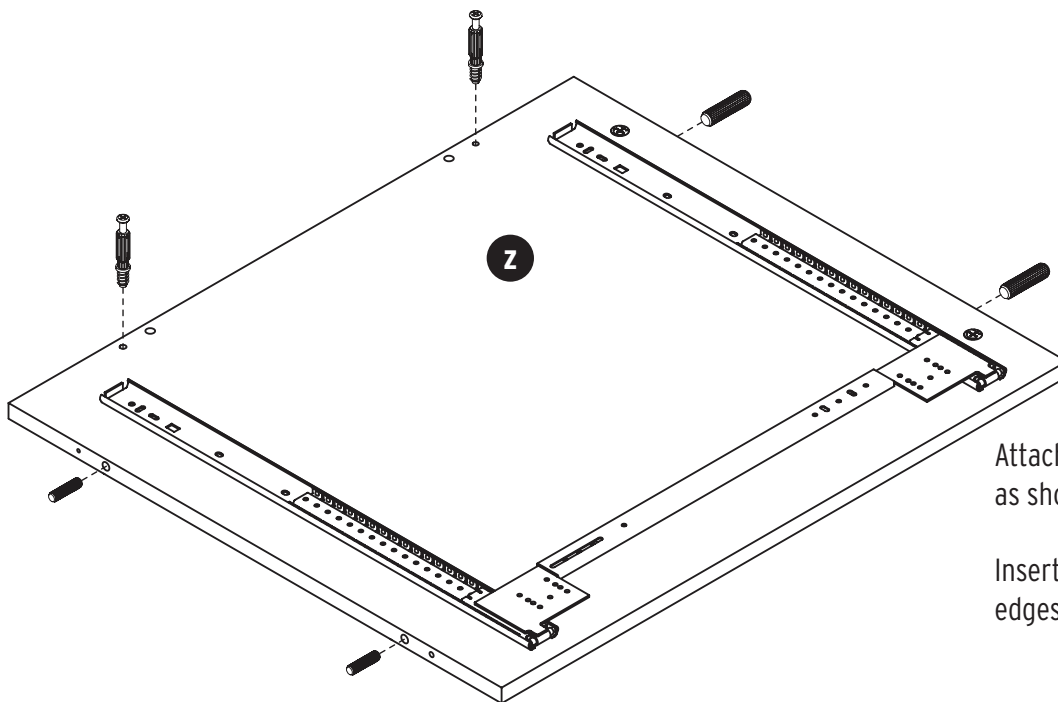
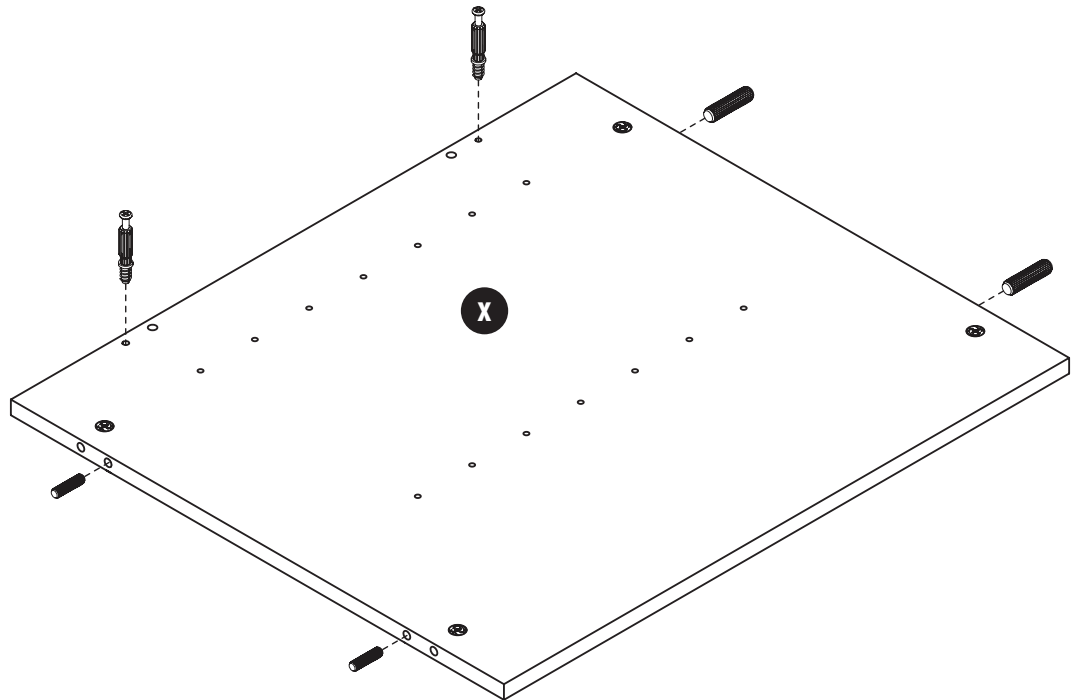
c1 6x35 Cam Bolt **x4**

Insert 4 **d1 Dowel Pins** into the edges of **Panel X** as shown.



Attach 2 **c1 Cam Bolts** to **Panel Z** as shown.

Insert 4 **d1 Dowel Pins** into the edges of **Panel Z** as shown.

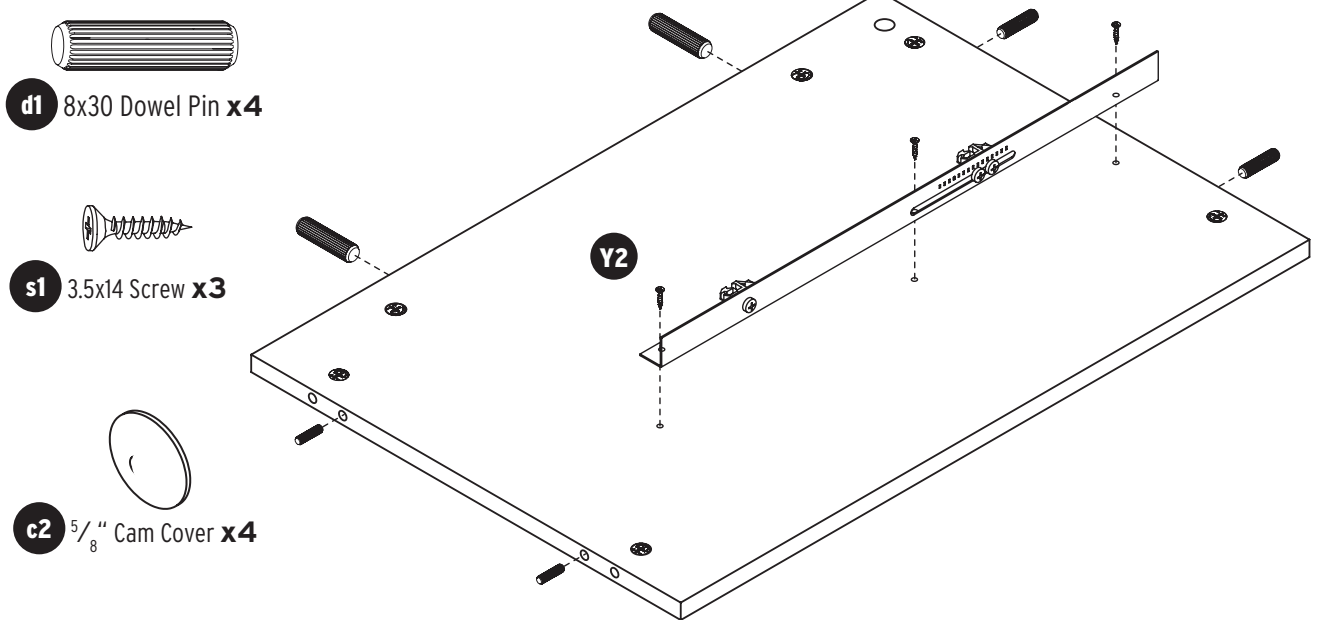
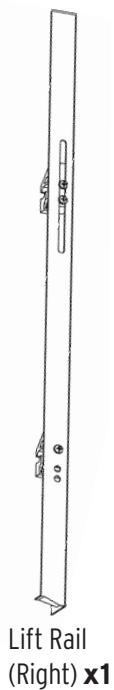
Attach the **Left Lift Rail** to **Panel Y1** with **s1 Screws** as shown.
Insert **d1 Dowel Pins** into the edges of **Panel Y1** as shown.



s1 3.5x14 Screw **x3**

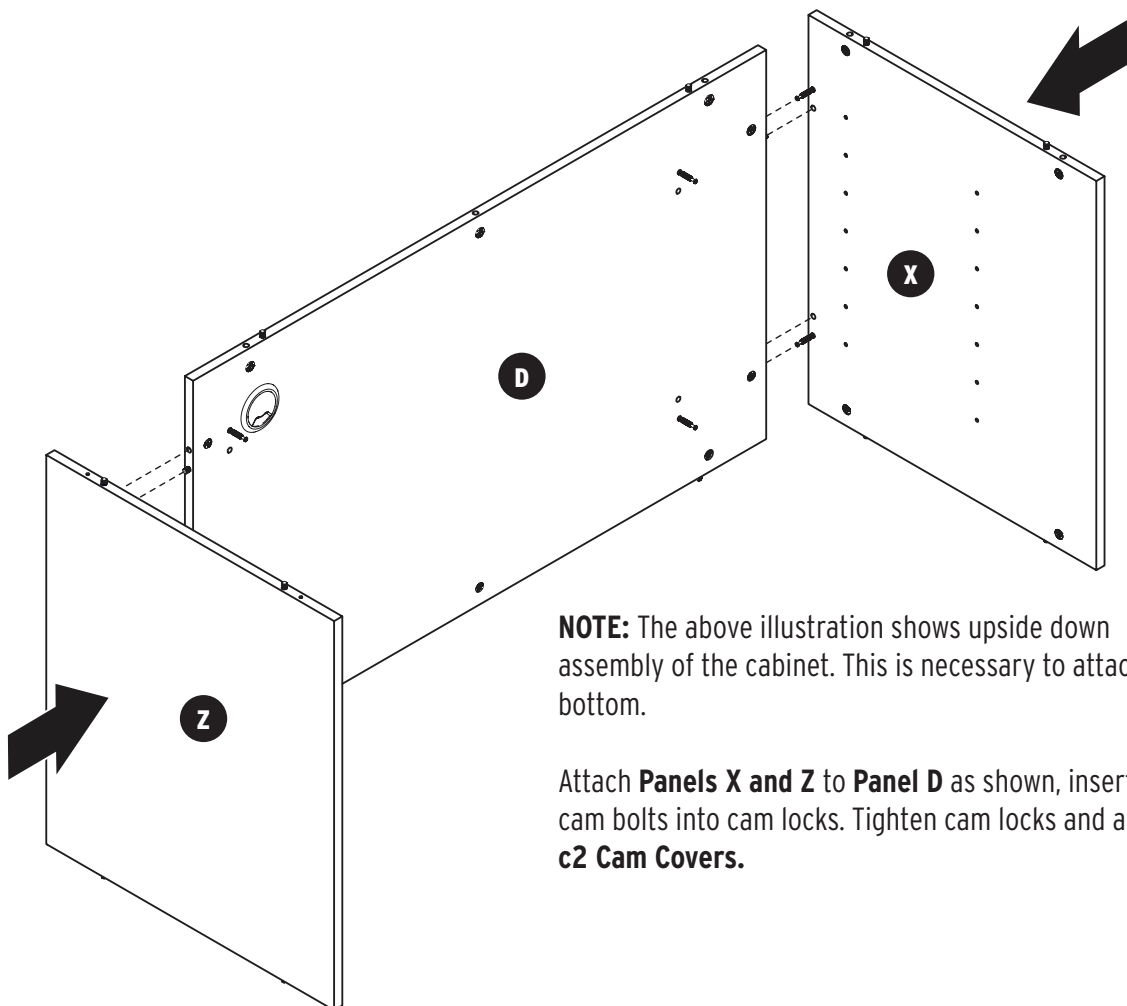
TIP: Spray a small amount of WD-40 or similar lubricant onto a paper towel and wipe the newly installed rails. This will make lift installation and operation easier.

Part 1: Main Cabinet



Attach the **Right Lift Rail** to **Panel Y2** with **s1 Screws** as shown.

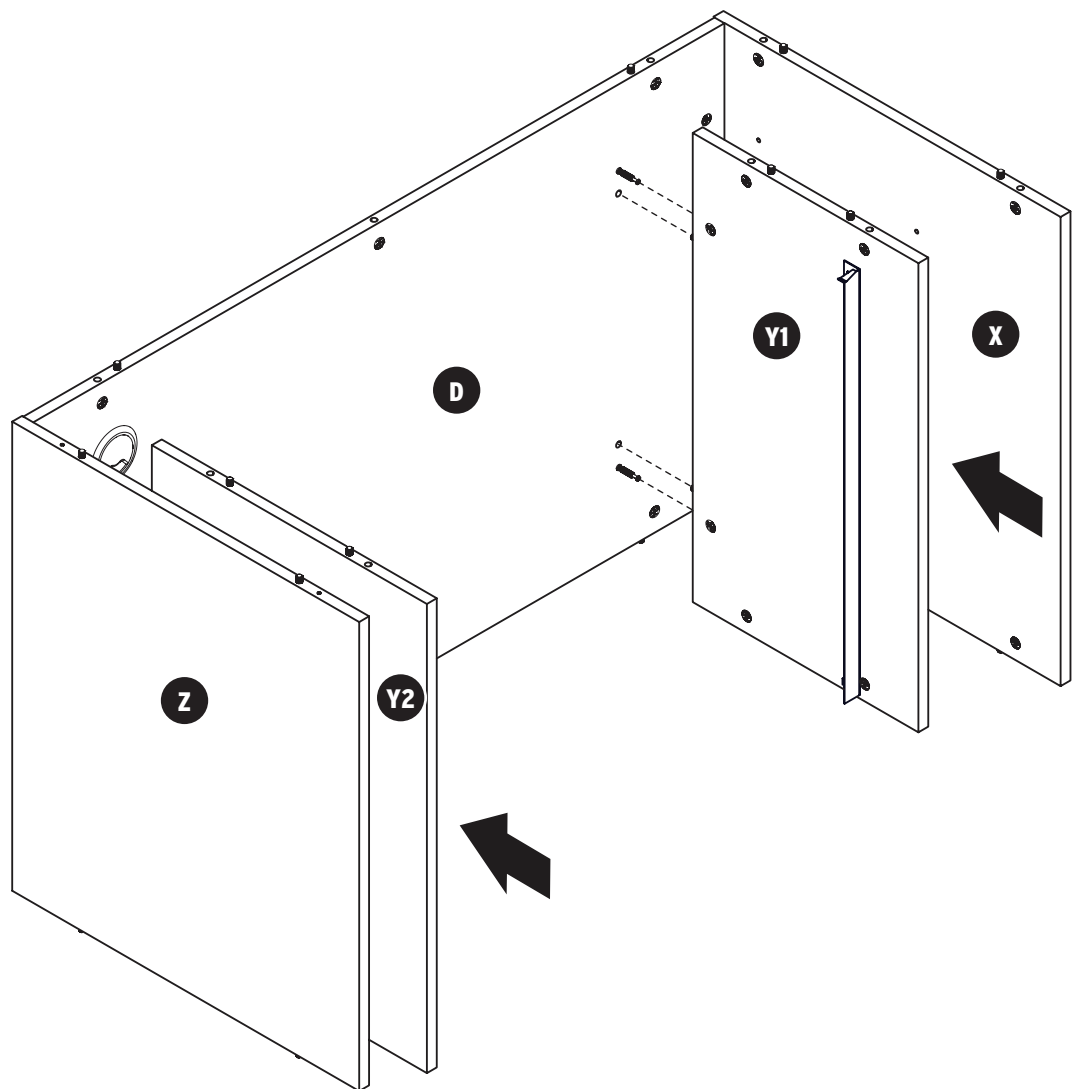
TIP: Spray a small amount of WD-40 or similar lubricant onto a paper towel and wipe the newly installed rails. This will make lift installation and operation easier.



NOTE: The above illustration shows upside down assembly of the cabinet. This is necessary to attach the bottom.

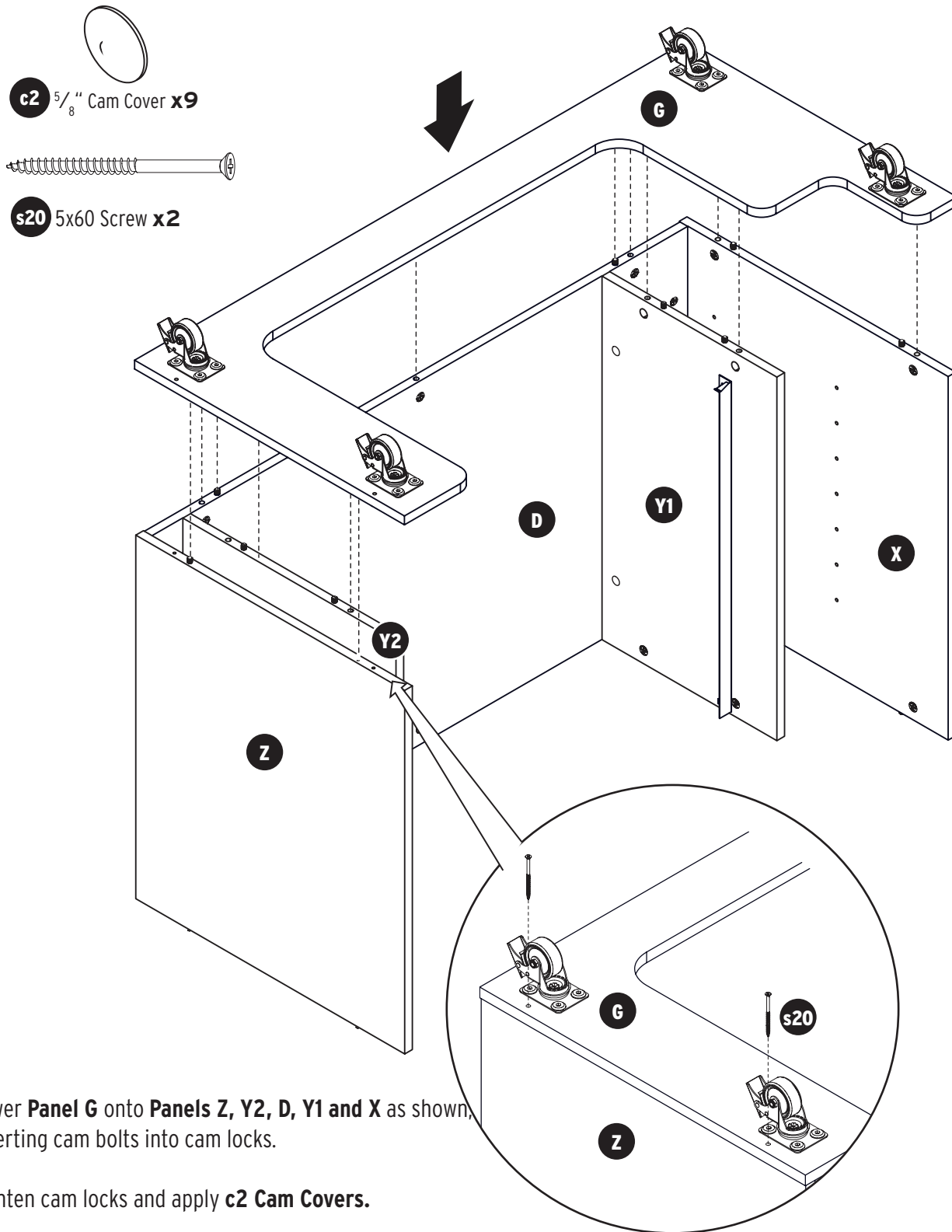
Attach **Panels X and Z** to **Panel D** as shown, inserting cam bolts into cam locks. Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.

Attach **Panels Y1 and Y2** to **Panel D** as shown, inserting cam bolts into cam locks. Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.

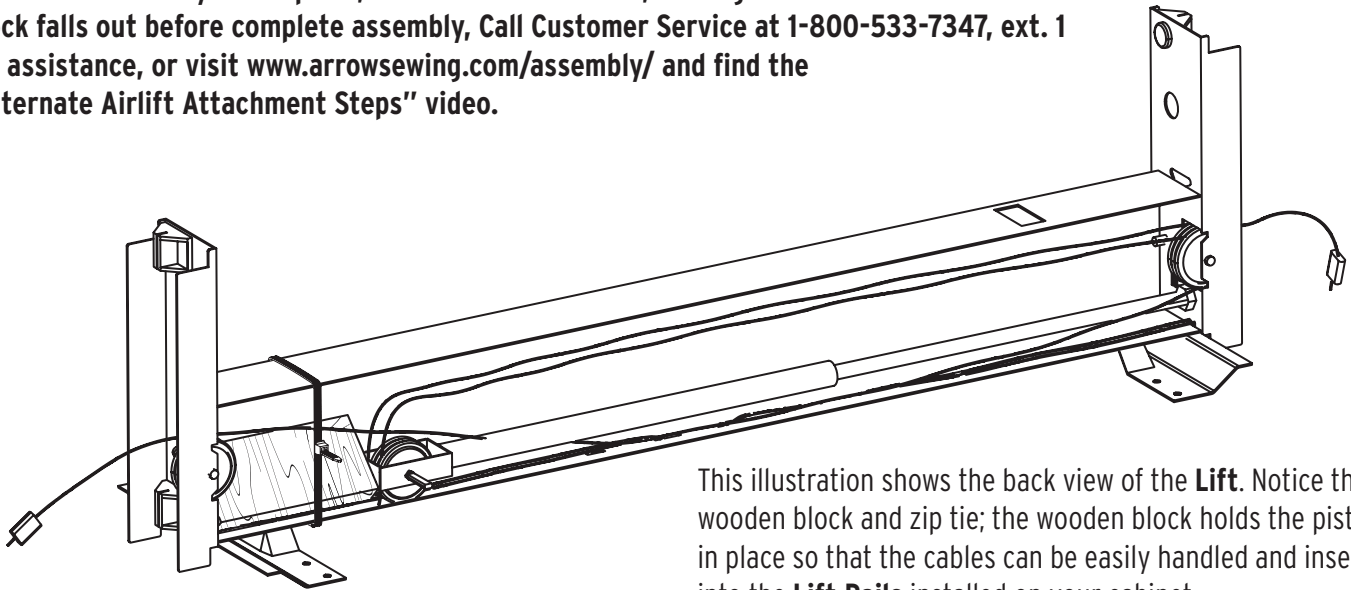


Make sure casters are locked and flip cabinet over onto its casters. You may need a friend to help you, but it is not required.

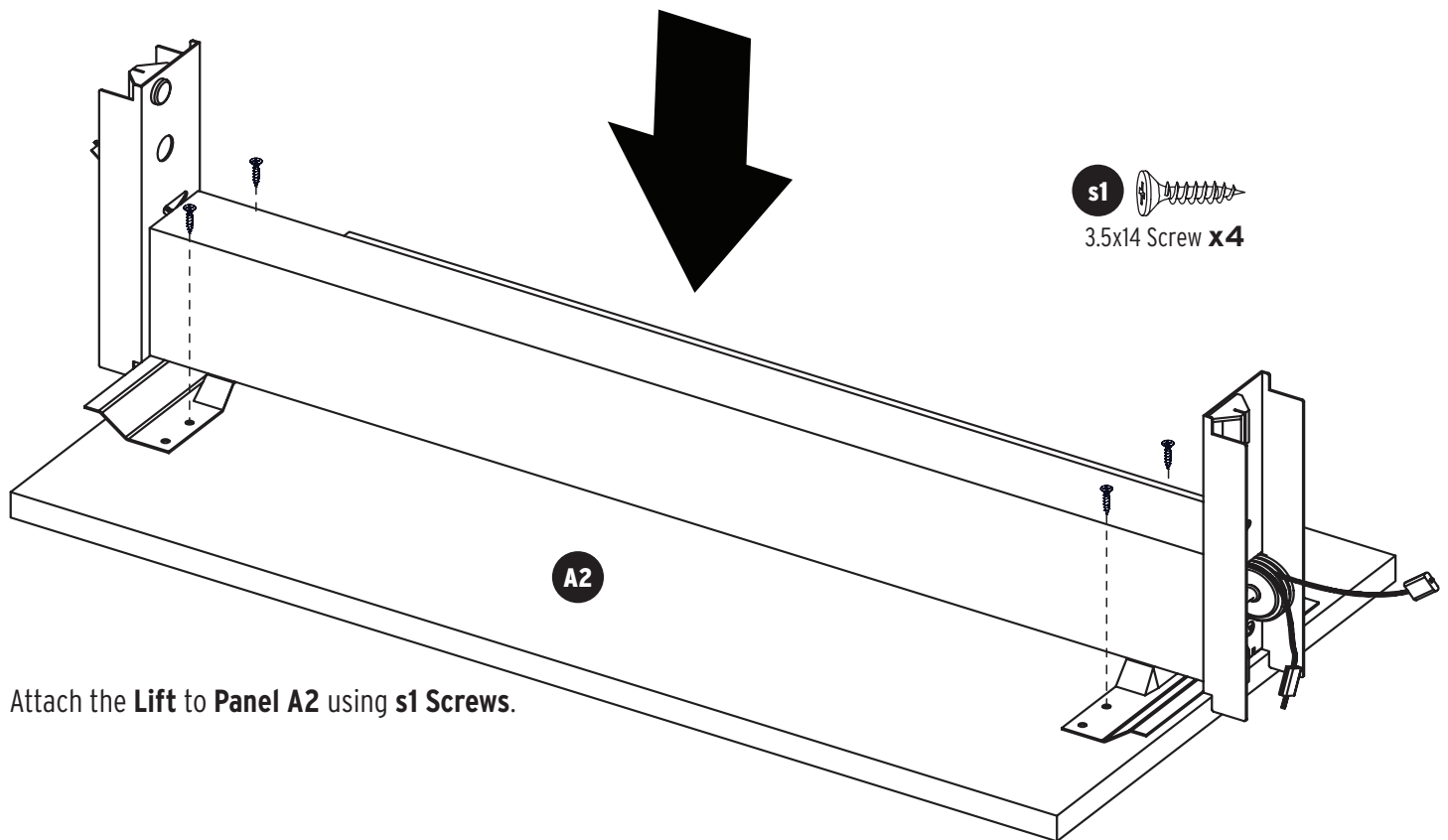
Part 2: Lift

LIFT INSTALLATION WARNING:

DO NOT remove the small wooden block from the Lift until assembly is complete. If the block is removed or falls out before lift assembly is complete, the cables will retract, making installation difficult. If the block falls out before complete assembly, Call Customer Service at 1-800-533-7347, ext. 1 for assistance, or visit www.arrowsewing.com/assembly/ and find the "Alternate Airlift Attachment Steps" video.

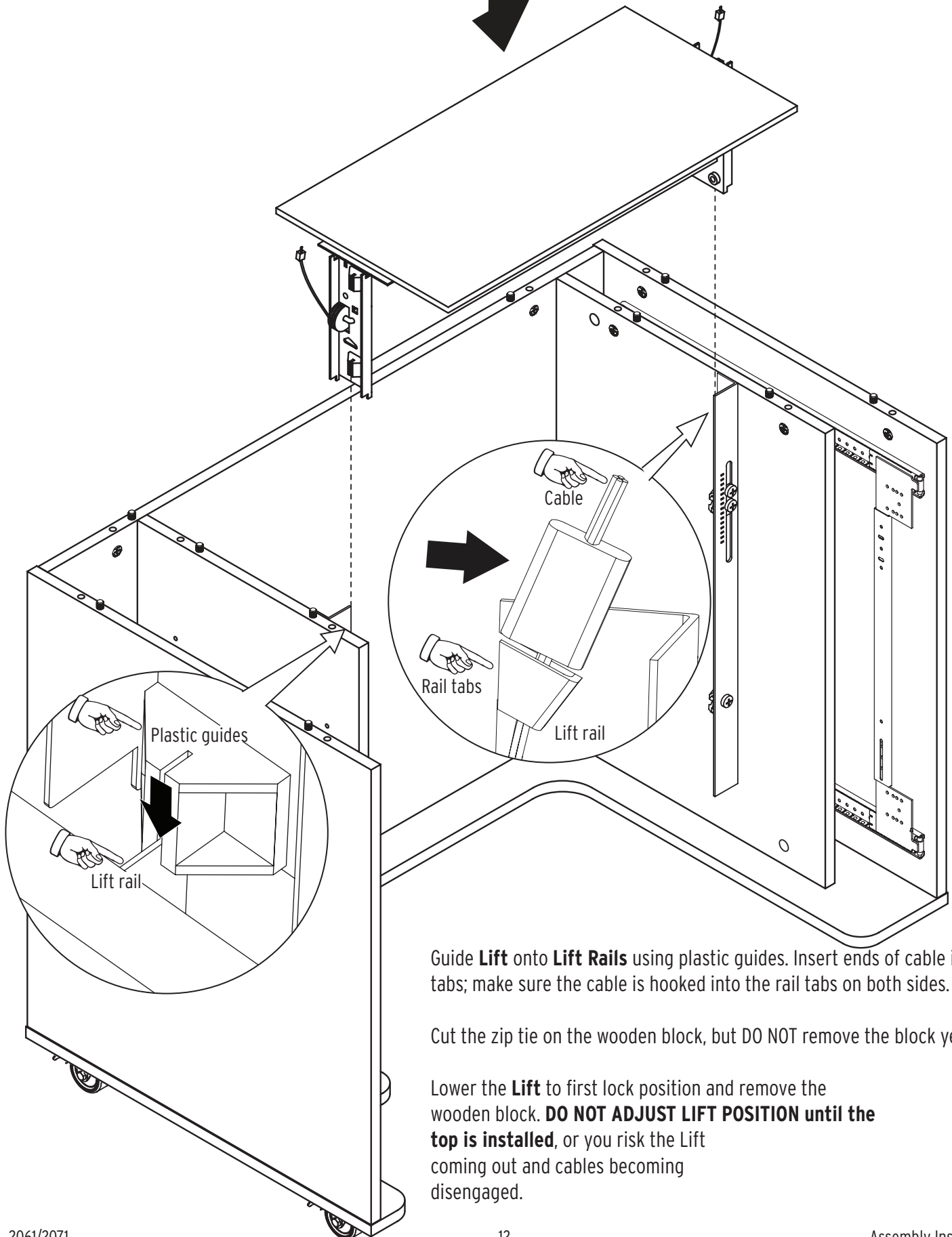


This illustration shows the back view of the **Lift**. Notice the wooden block and zip tie; the wooden block holds the piston in place so that the cables can be easily handled and inserted into the **Lift Rails** installed on your cabinet.



Attach the **Lift** to **Panel A2** using **s1 Screws**.

Part 2: Lift



Guide **Lift** onto **Lift Rails** using plastic guides. Insert ends of cable into rail tabs; make sure the cable is hooked into the rail tabs on both sides.

Cut the zip tie on the wooden block, but **DO NOT** remove the block yet.

Lower the **Lift** to first lock position and remove the wooden block. **DO NOT ADJUST LIFT POSITION until the top is installed**, or you risk the Lift coming out and cables becoming disengaged.

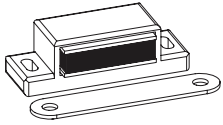

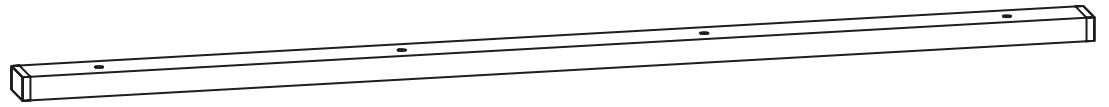

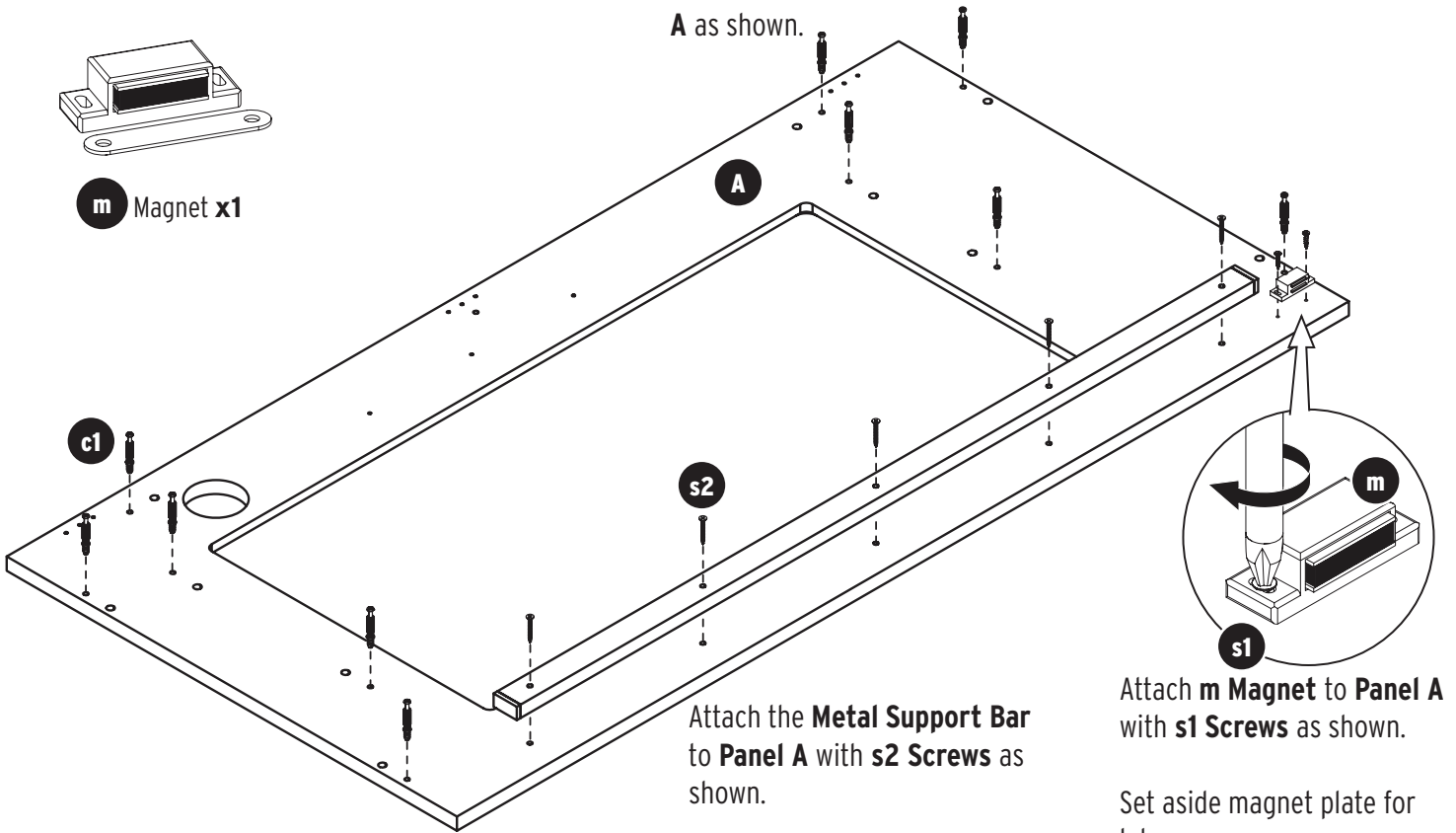

Attach the **Metal Support Bar** to **Panel A** with **s2** Screws as shown.

Attach **m** Magnet to **Panel A** with **s1** Screws as shown.

Set aside magnet plate for later use.

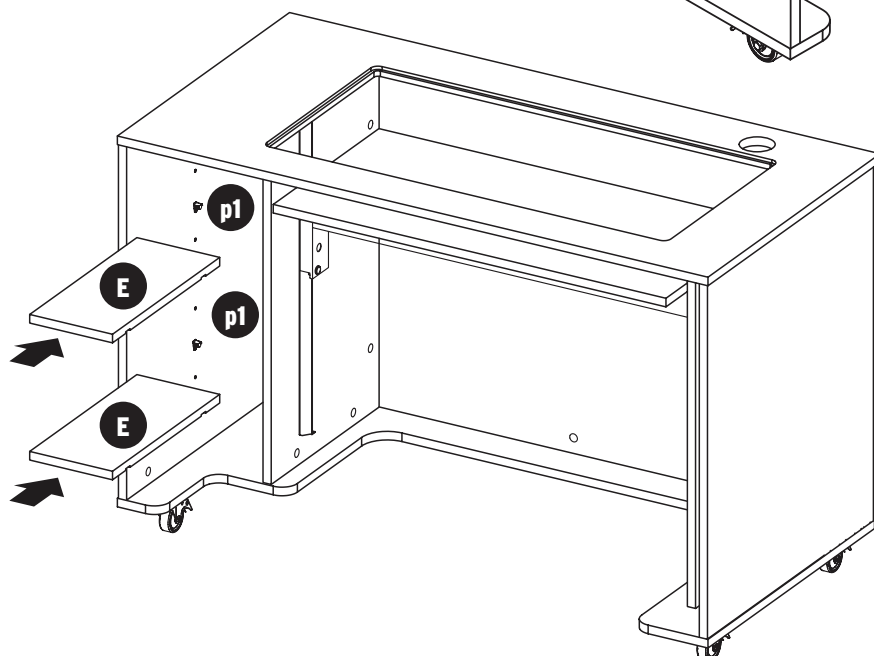
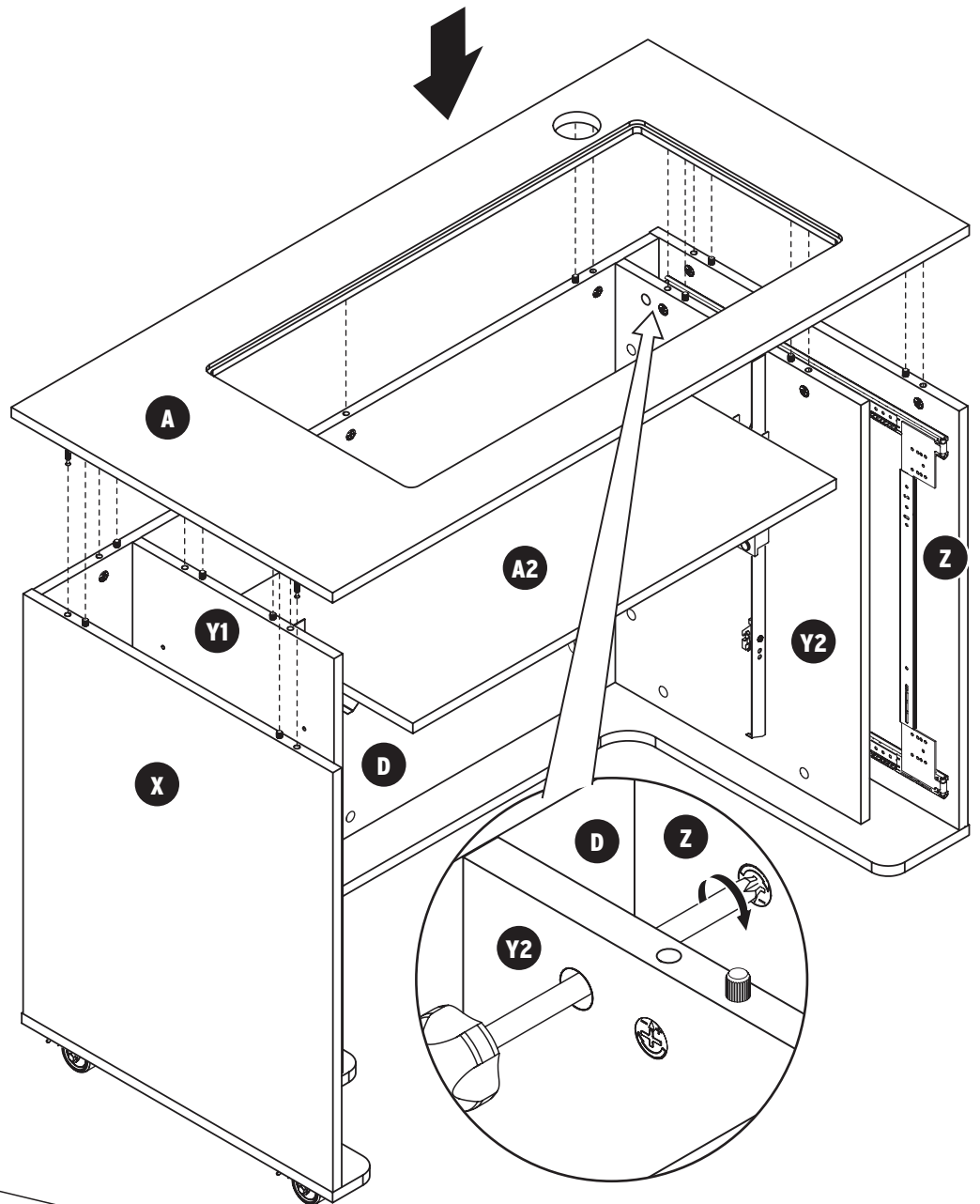
Part 3: Top and Shelves



Lower **Panel A** onto **Panels X, Y1, D, Y2 and Z**, inserting cam bolts into cam locks.

Tighten cam locks and cover with **c2 Cam Covers**.

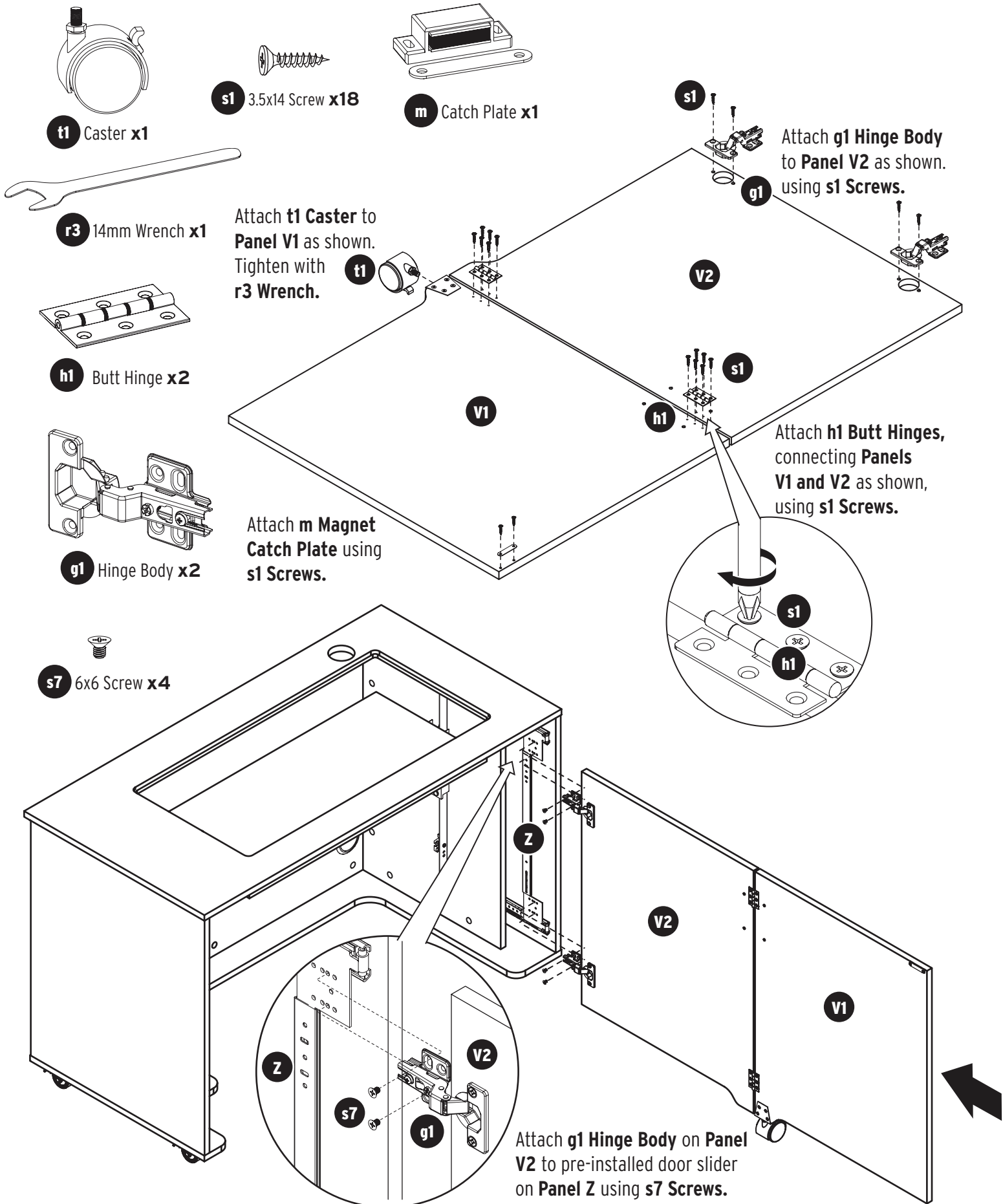
Note the small hole in the back right corner. See inset illustration; you will need a long screwdriver to reach through the hole and tighten the cam lock.



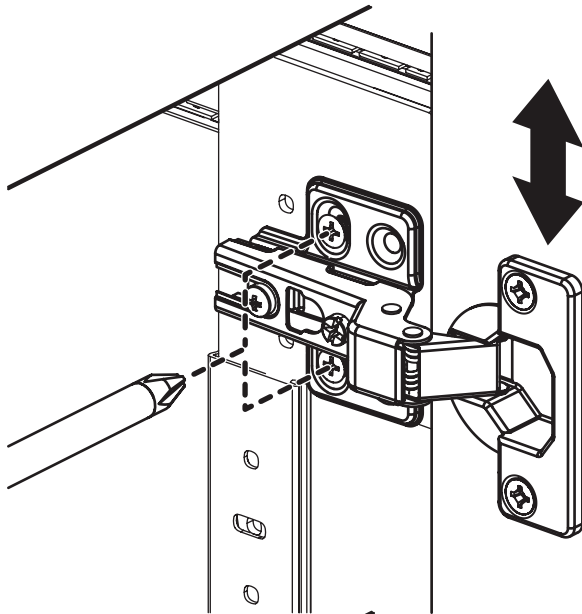
Insert **p1 Pegs** into pre-drilled **Panels X and Y1**, taking care to be sure the pegs are evenly spaced.

Slide **Panel E** shelves into place as shown.

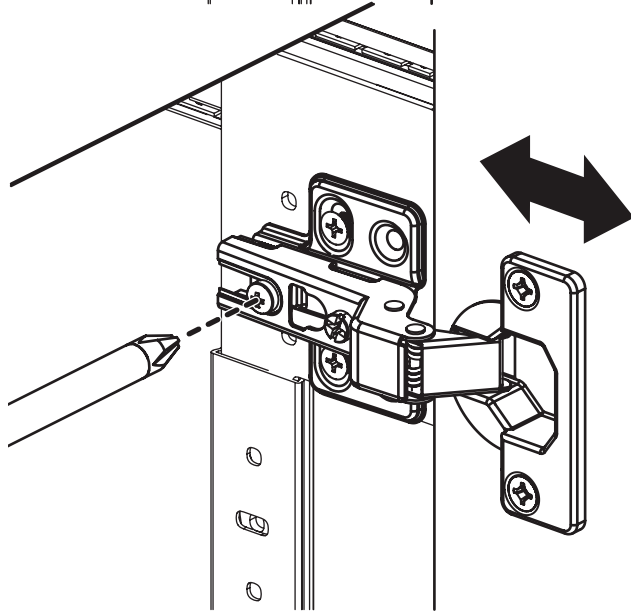


Part 4: Door - Adjusting the Hinges



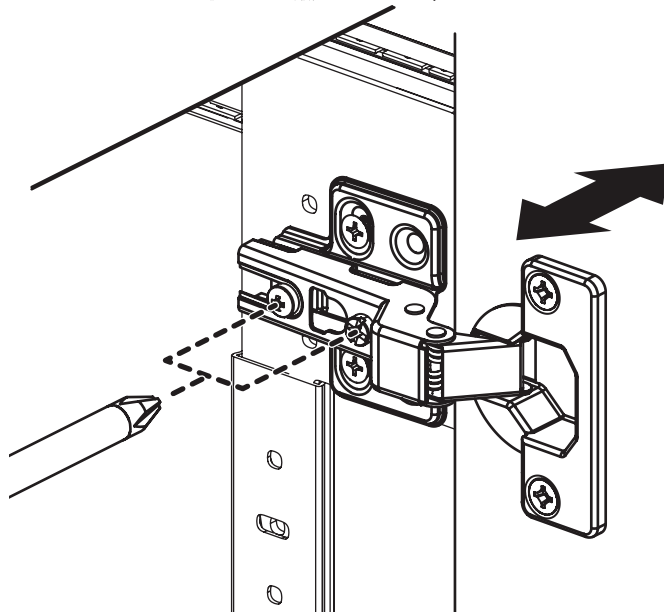
Adjust hinge vertically:

Loosen the screws indicated and slide the hinge body up or down to adjust vertical position of your hinge.



Adjust hinge horizontally:

Loosen the screw indicated and slide the hinge body left or right to adjust horizontal position of your hinge.



Adjust door depth:

Loosen the screws indicated and slide the hinge body in or out to adjust depth of your door.

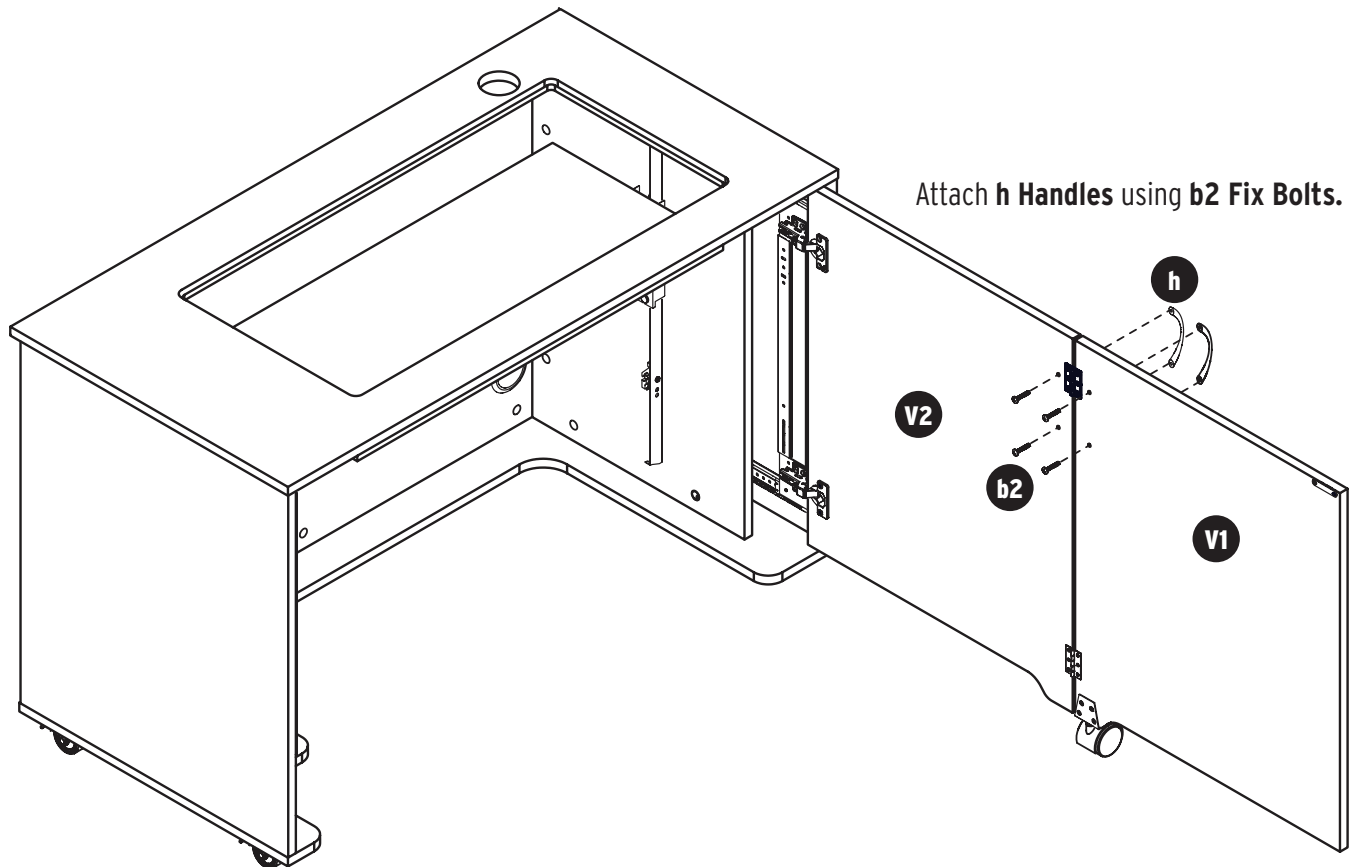

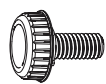

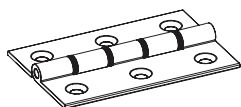


Attach **h** Handles using **b2** Fix Bolts.

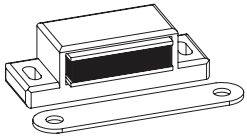


Attach **t1** Casters to **Panels 01** and **02** as illustrated. Tighten with **Wrench**.

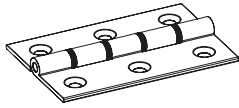
Attach **Panels 01** and **02** to **Panel D** as illustrated, using **s1** Screws to attach **h1** Butt Hinges.

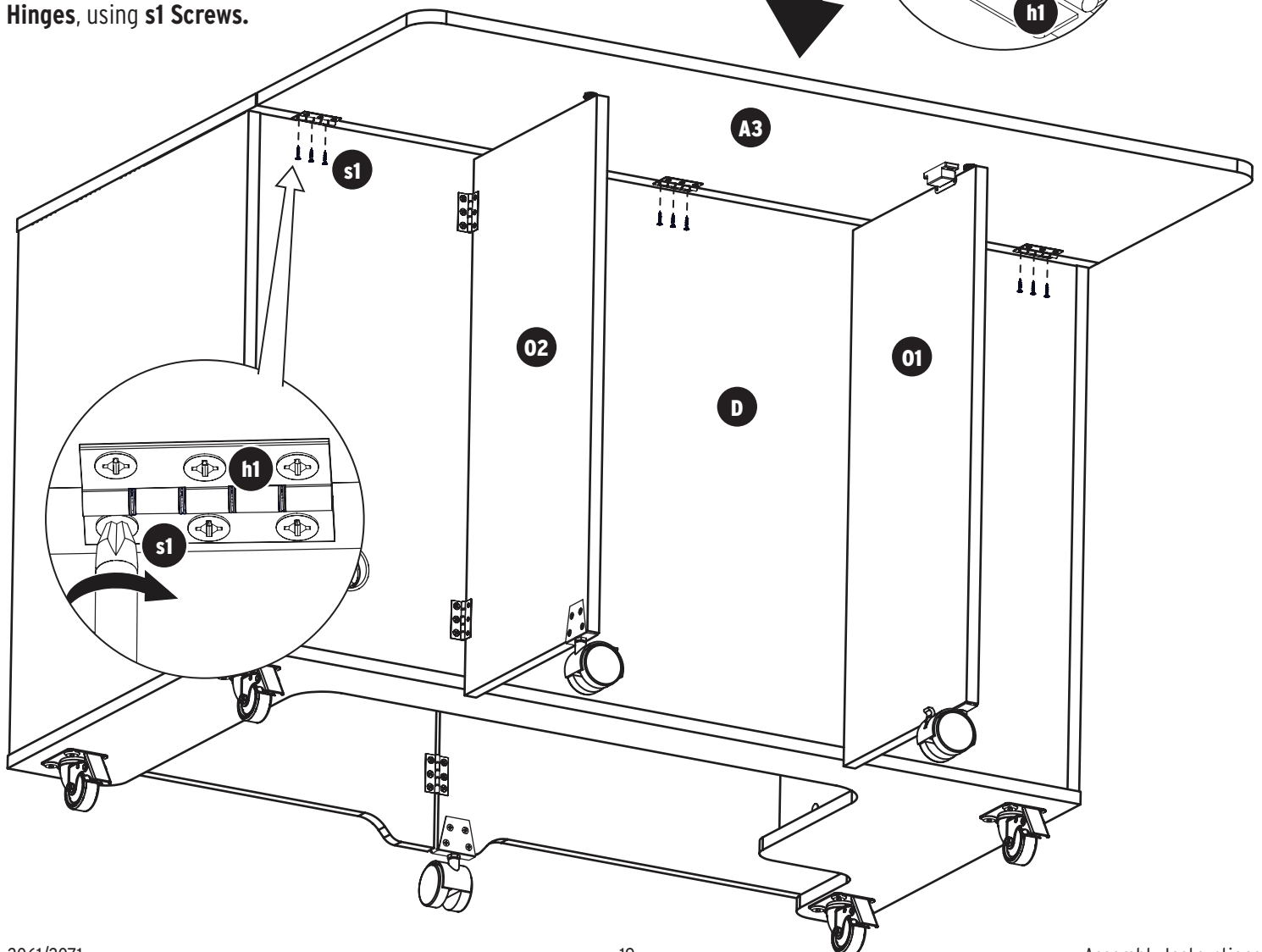

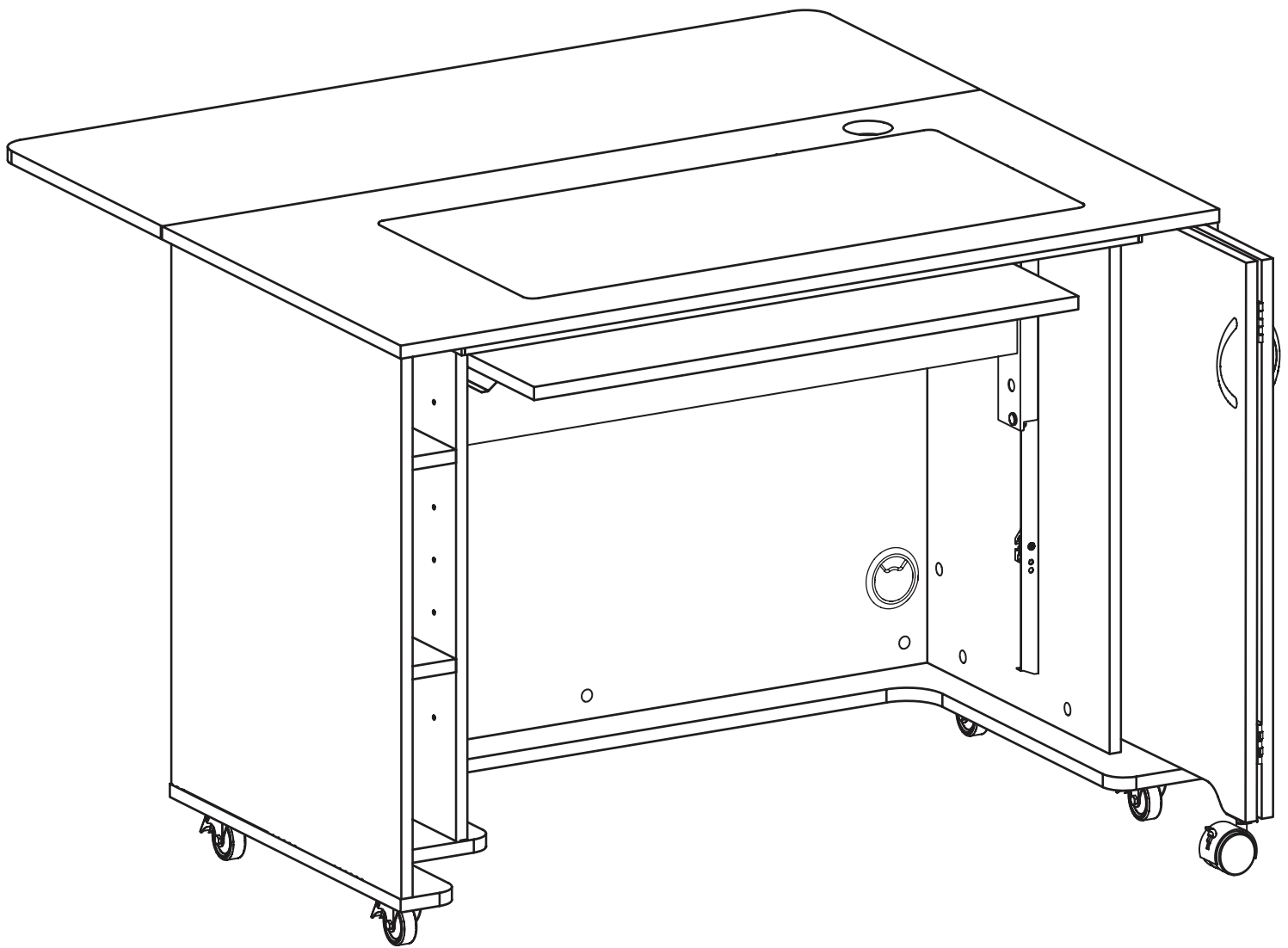

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

Kangaroo™ Sewing Furniture Limited Lifetime Warranty

WHAT THIS WARRANTY COVERS: Arrow Companies, LLC "Arrow" provides a Limited Lifetime Warranty "Warranty" to the original purchaser of this product against defects in materials or workmanship of furniture components. As used in this Warranty, "defect" means imperfections in components which substantially impair the utility of the product. This Warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state. Electrical and mechanical components of furniture are warranted for 5 years.

HOW TO GET SERVICE: Simply contact Arrow at 1-800-533-7347 or CS@ArrowSewing.com. When you request Warranty service, you must also present proof of purchase documentation, which includes the date of purchase (detailed receipt), and photos of the product. Arrow will replace any defective part (at its sole option), excluding labor. Replacement parts will be warranted for only the remaining period of the original Warranty.

Replacement parts will be shipped freight prepaid on any initial Warranty claim during first year of Warranty only. Warranty applies only to defects confirmed by Arrow and will be replaced or repaired at Arrow's option. In the event parts are no longer available for a Warranty claim, customer may receive a brand new cabinet at a price equal to 60% off the MSRP of a current comparable model.

WHAT'S NOT COVERED: There is no Warranty coverage for defects or conditions that result from the following: Failure to follow product assembly instructions, information or warnings; misuse or abuse; intentional damage; fire, flood, alteration or modification of the product; use of the product in a manner inconsistent with its intended use; any condition resulting from incorrect or inadequate maintenance, cleaning, care or neglect; cuts or scratches; caster damage as a result of moving furniture fully loaded or with locked casters; damage resulting from electrical surge or lightning; or use in commercial or education environments. Arrow Sewing Furniture is designed for residential use only.

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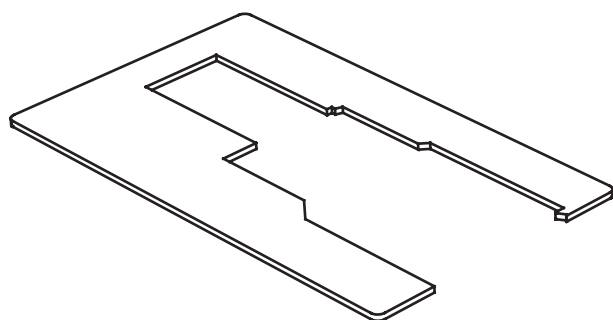

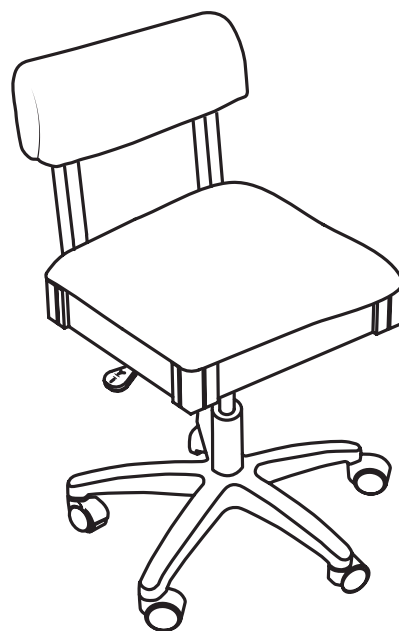
